for Soldiers, a non-profit organization which will then quickly wipe off all personal information and check to see if device is repairable. Devices are either repaired and sold or recycled for parts. Funds are used to provide free communication services for soldiers and emergency funding for veterans. More than 300 million minutes of talk time have been provided to our troops serving around the world. The Helping Heroes Home program provides emergency funds that have assisted more than 3,100 veterans so far.
